# **RAIN** and more RAIN!



With ALL the rain we've had this year, we thought we'd give you some tips about water in your home. Remember, March and April are both generally rainy months.

## **Water at Home**

**Reseal your basement** - can cause damage to the foundation of the home.

**Hoses and faucets** attached to indoor appliances for damage or leaks, especially the clothes washing machine.

Showers and tubs - check and re-caulk if needed.

Check all your **normal plumbing pipes** for damage and leaks.

Know where your main water shut-off value is in case of an emergency.

Point drains and run-off away from the building - cause erosion and foundation damage.

Check the **gutter downspouts** for blockages and debris.

Check your **doors and windows** - caulk and seal as needed.



Check sprinklers and irrigation systems for damage and leaks.

#### **Water Information**

When it comes to water damage, there are three types of water!

- "Clean" water from rain or a leaky pipe. This water is generally easy to clean up and if caught quickly may not do much damage.
- "Gray" water that is slightly dirty from washing machines, clean toilets, etc. Clean up and damage depends on the source. You may need professional help or advice.
- "Black" water from sewer systems, rivers, etc. This water is dangerous. It may
  contain waste, bacteria, and other contaminants. Do NOT attempt to clean up this
  mess yourself. Call for professional help.

All water can lead to mold! Which can be toxic to you, your family, and your pets.

**After water damage**, any materials that are porous, such as carpet, insulation, fabric, should be thrown away immediately. Water damaged wood should also be replaced as soon as possible.


