Allium represents unity for the way multiple blossoms grow from a single bulb.

Amaranthus symbolize eternity, immortality, and everlasting love.

Ambrosia - Your love is reciprocated

Anemone - excitement and anticipation thanks to their early spring bloom. White for purity, red for love, and purple for protection.

Alstroemeria symbolizes devotion, wealth, prosperity and fortune—all good things to wish upon your new life as a married couple.

Aster -Symbol of Love, Daintiness

Baby's Breath generally symbolizes innocence and purity of heart.

Bells of Ireland - Good luck

Birds of Paradise represent faithfulness.

Calla Lilies represent devotion, holiness, and purity of the bride.

Carnations - White carnations symbolize pure love and adoration. Pink carnations say "I'll never forget you"

Celosia - Unfading love

Chamomiles are associated with joy and positivity.

Chrysanthemums, or **mums**, stand for hope.

Cornflower - Delicacy, Refinement

Craspedia often referred to as "billy balls," represent wholeness, completeness, and good health.

Daffodils mean regard.

Dahlias represents pride and inner strength.

Daisy symbolize loyal love, gentleness and innocence.

Eucalyptus brings with it a sense of protection.

Ferns stand for fascination, sincerity and magic.

Forget Me Not - True love, Faithfulness, Remembrance

Forsythia - Anticipation, Innocence

Freesias - feelings of innocence.

Gardenias represent purity, sweet love and communicate.

Gladiolus- Strength of character, Generosity

Hibiscus - Delicate beauty

Honeysuckle - Generosity

Hydrangeas are thought to be tied to deep emotion, representing understanding and apology.

Iris - Faith, Valour, Wisdom, Friendship

Ivy is a symbol of fidelity, wedded love, affection and friendship.

Jasmine - White jasmine is for amiability while yellow for modesty, grace and elegance.

Lavender - typically associated with serenity and tranquility. In recent decades, it has also become a symbolic marker for LGBTQ+ couples and weddings, appearing as a marker of resistance, strength, and peace.

Lemon Blossom - Fidelity in love

Lilacs - White lilacs represent youthful innocence and purity. Purple lilacs represent the first emotion of love.

Lilly of the valley conveys majesty, truth and honour.

Magnolia - Nobility, perseverance, and love of nature

Morning Glory - Affection

Olive Branches - stand for peace.

Orange Blossom - Innocence, Purity, Eternal love, Marriage

Orchids are often said to represent beauty itself, love, fertility, and virility.

Pansy - Thoughtful reflection, Merriment

Peony's - blushing pink it symbolizes love and affection. Wealth, honor, and good fortune have also been ascribed to the flower.

Phlox - "Our souls are united"

Poppies have a less romantic meaning, often representing sleep and death. In modern times, have come to symbolize peace and remembrance.

Queen Anne's Lace - Haven, Fantasy

Ranunculus showcase strength in softness.

Roses - especially in a classic red shade—symbolize passionate romance.

Rosemary is a symbol of remembrance.

Smilax, a commonly used leafy vine, is a symbol of loveliness.

Spider Flower - Elope with me

Statice - Remembrance

Stephanotis stands for marital happiness.

Stock communicates a sense of affection, lasting beauty and the sentiment that "you'll always be beautiful to me."

Sweet Pea - Gratitude and contentment are often associated with the sweet pea. It can also symbolize pleasure, happiness and joy.

Tiger Lilies are a symbol of wealth and pride.

Tulips - a symbol of love and passion. Red tulips are a declaration of love, white tulips stand for worthiness in love and yellow tulips convey the feeling that "there's sunshine in your smile."

Veronica - Fidelity

Wisteria - symbolism has expanded to include devotion and long-lasting love
